NACTE 2010 Summer Conference Logo Contest Rules

Once again NACTE (Nevada Association of Career and Technical Education) is sponsoring a student competition for secondary and post-secondary CTE students to design the 2010 Conference Logo. The winning design for the NACTE 2010 Summer Conference Logo will be selected by the NACTE Board at their February 2010 board meeting.

Remember, this logo will be used in a variety of places: flyers, conference programs, name tags, websites, etc. Be careful using too many colors, text sizes, small shapes, etc. It should not be too busy. Previous conference logos can be viewed at: www.nacteonline.org under "Events." The submitted digital artwork will not be returned to the student. Any design that is not considered appropriate by the board will not be considered. **A \$100.00 cash prize will be awarded to the selected winner.**

Design Criteria:

1. The finished design must represent the conference theme – **IT'S SHOWTIME.**
2. The finished dimensions of the digital artwork will be submitted in two sizes of identical artwork:
3. 4" x 4" and 8" x 8" saved as a *.jpg, *.tif, or *.eps files
4. File sizes must be less than 5 MB.
5. The design should be in color. Use a minimum of two colors; full color designs are acceptable.
6. The logo must be your original design. No copyrighted material (downloads, scans, photos, etc.) will be accepted.

Who Can Enter:

1. Secondary and postsecondary students enrolled in a CTE courses may enter.
2. Entries must be developed by qualifying students.
3. Students may only submit their own designs.
4. Only one (1) entry per student.
5. The design must be approved by the student's teacher prior to becoming eligible for electronic display and voting.

 - a. Student's name
 - b. School
 - c. CTE class
 - d. Teacher's name
 - e. Both sizes of artwork, no larger than 5 MB per file
